We welcome recent research outputs that promote the development of the home economics discipline. We especially consider presentations that embody the 2025 ARAHE Congress Theme: EMPOWERING FUTURE GENERATIONS: HOME ECONOMICS IN THE AGE OF ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY and the sub-themes.

SUBTHEMES:

Smart Homes, Smart Families

Studies on the use of advanced technology from smart kitchen appliances to digital tools such as budgeting and financial apps, Al-assisted wardrobe planning, interior decoration, or nutrition intervention plans among others

Digital Literacy in Home Economics Curriculum

Integrating technology in HE education that can revolutionize the learning experience from interactive and immersive tools like virtual reality simulations to data analytics for tailoring instruction or research to meet individual student needs

Sustainability and Green Consumption

Programs, policies, or systems that promote sustainability practices like monitoring or reducing energy consumption, minimizing food waste, managing e-wastes or fostering a generation of eco-citizens

DATES TO REMEMBER!!

September 1, 2024 – Submission of Extended Abstract for Oral/Poster Presentation
December 31, 2024 - Deadline for Submission of Extended Abstract
February 28, 2025 - Release of Extended Abstract Review
March 31, 2025 - Submission of Revised Oral Presentation Abstract
August 9, 2025 - Oral and Poster Presentations

All research presentations will be included in the Conference's Book of Abstracts. Certificate of presentation will be provided only to the presenting author and co-authors in attendance. For multiple authors, all the names will appear in the certificate.

WHO MAY SUBMIT?

ARAHE individual members are qualified to submit and present their papers. At least, the primary author or the senior author must be an individual member if paper has multiple authors. Upon submission of abstract, the official receipt or copy of the membership card must be included in the email. For those who are not yet members, you must register as an individual member during the congress and indicate during submission.

MEMBERSHIP ELIGIBILITY

You can qualify for membership if you are a faculty member, practitioner in the field (public, private/corporate, volunteer), alumni or graduate student of the home economics disciplines and related fields.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES FOR ORAL & POSTER PRESENTATIONS

Extended abstract of presentations must be submitted in MS Word file.

PARTS OF EXTENDED ABSTRACT

An extended abstract contains more detailed information on the research questions or objectives, the methodology, and results. The major parts include a <u>brief introduction</u>, the <u>statement of the research problem and specific research questions or objectives</u>. The <u>methodology</u> must include a description of the <u>research design</u>, <u>sample and sampling procedure</u>, <u>instrument</u>, <u>data gathering procedure</u>, and <u>data analysis</u> used. Please include information of the research ethic guidelines followed in the conduct of the study. Describe the major <u>results</u> of the study and the answers to the research question or objective. The last parts of the extended abstract are the <u>conclusions</u> and <u>recommendations</u>.

The extended abstract may be up to 300 to 500 (maximum) words. This is to enable a substantial review of submitted papers for presentations. In the Book of Abstracts to be published, however, the abstract will be reduced to a maximum of 300 words.

APPLICATION FORM FOR ORAL AND POSTER PRESENTATION

Upon submission of application, the official receipt or copy of the ARAHE membership card must be included in the email. For those who are not yet members, you must register as an individual member during the congress and indicate in the application form.

If the paper you are to present is an output of a thesis/dissertation, download and fill-in the Mentor's Statement of Support and include in the submission.
