**Objectives of the Award**

1. Motivate local HE associations to come up with programs and projects promoting home economics education.
2. Uplift the social, economic, and cultural status of members and the community through the association.
3. Recognize the best performing associations through their achievements/accomplishments.
4. Share best practices of each association for duplication, imitation or simulation in other Divisions or regions.

The participants to the search for Best Performing Home Economics Related Organization (HERO) Award must comply with the following requirements:

1. Certificate of affiliation to the Philippine Home Economics Association.
2. Must have at least 15 members who have attended PHEA NC & T (each member attended at least one PHEA NC & T)
3. Duly recognized by the Division Office through Memorandum, Advisory or Miscellaneous Letter.
4. Has successfully implemented at least two (2) projects within the year with documentation reports.
5. Bring a vertical tarp (with stand) complete description, data, and pictures about their accomplishments.
6. Associations may show videos of their accomplishments beside their tarps using laptops.

The tarps will be displayed along the hallways of the venue for the entire duration of the PHEA NC and T where participants could make a gallery walk. A designated Board of Evaluators will determine the Best Performing Home Economics Association based on set criteria. The winners will be announced at the closing program of the NC and T.
